

CROCHET SNOWFLAKE



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This is an original crochet pattern that uses basic crochet stitches worked in the round to create a simple but stellar snowflake shape.

Use them around a Christmas party as coasters or make a set of these to string together for a winter garland.

For this project you will need:

- * 1 Golden Naural Premium Cotton cord 5mm
- * Crochet hook 10mm
- * Scissors

LEVEL: Five circular icons, each containing a stylized white 'B' on a black background, representing the difficulty level of the project.



Crochet techniques:

ch - chain

sl st- slip stitch

dc- double crochet



To begin: make a Magic Ring

Round 1: 12 dc in Magic Ring; join with a sl st to the top of the first dc

TIP: Gently tighten the magic ring to leave a small hole for a better effect.



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Round 2: ch 3, sl st into dc from round 1; repeat 11 times;



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Round 3:

Step 1: ch2, dc in the chain space, ch3, sl st into dc, ch5, sl st into dc, ch3, sl st into dc, ch2, sl st into sl st from Round 2



Round 3:

Step 2: ch1, dc into chain space, ch1, sl st into sl st from Round 2

Repeat step 1 and step 2 5 times in sequence





Snowflakes can be made of Premium Cotton Cord 5 mm and Junior Cotton Cord 3 mm. It can be used as a tea cup pad, candle stand or just as a decorative element. It would be perfect as a Christmas tree ornament.
