

Bobbingy

Summer Tote
Bag





You will need:

- About 270m of 3mm Braided Cord (we used Sand color)
- 6mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Knitting marker
- Measure tape

You will be using:

- Single crochet
- Chain stitch
- Double crochet
- Slip stitch



Step 1

Let's start!

Make 17 chain loops. Tutorial [here](#).



Step 2

Make a single crochet stitch in every loop.
At the end of the row, make one chain loop
and turn your project, we will be working
back and forth.

Step 3

At this stage, the bottom of the bag should look like in the photo above.

Tip: try to work the stitches tightly.



Step 4

Make 37 rows of single crochet stitches in total.

Dimensions of the bottom part: 33cm x 16cm.



Step 5

Let's move on to making the openwork part of the bag. Now, we will be working in rounds. In the last loop of the last row, make 4 chain stitches.



Step 6

We will be inserting the crochet hook into every second stitch.



Step 7

Insert the crochet hook and make a double
crochet stitch.

Step 8

After making one double crochet, make 2 chain loop, then again insert the crochet hook skipping one loop.



Step 9

Work the next stitches in the same way until you make the first edge of the bottom.

Insert the knitting marker in the first loop of this round.



Step 10

At this stage your project should look like in the photo above.



Step 11

We will work the second edge of the bottom in exactly the same way, inserting the hook into every other stitch and making double crochet stitch and then 2 chain loops.



Step 12

The second edge is done!



Step 13

Work the third edge in the same way.



Step 14

Work the last edge in the same way, making one double crochet stitch and 2 chain loops in every second loop.



Step 15

Now, we will be making the second round. Insert the crochet hook in the third chain loop, and make the double crochet stitch and 2 chain loops.



Step 16

Now, we will be inserting the crochet hook in each loop from the previous double crochet stitch and continue making double crochet stitch and 2 chain loops.



Step 17

At this stage your bag should look like in the photo above.



Step 18

Work 16 rounds in total.



Step 19

When you make the last loop of the round, make 2 chain loops, insert the crochet hook in the marked place and make a slip stitch.

Step 20

Now, we will be making single crochet stitches. Make two single crochet stitches then skip one loop, and again make two single crochet stitches and skip one loop. Make one round in this way.



Step 21

Fold the bag in half (make sure you fold it evenly by counting the stitches), and start making the second round, when you are 16 cm from the edge, make 70 chain stitches for the bag's handle.



Step 22

Measure 16 cm from the other edge of the bag and attach the bag strap with a slip stitch.

Continue making single crochet stitches, and make the second strap in the same way.



Step 23

When you attach the second bag strap, continue making single crochet stitches until you reach the first bag strap.



Step 24

Make a slip stitch in every chain loop of the strap. When you finish the first strap, continue making single crochet stitches until you reach the second strap of the bag.



Step 25

When you make the second strap, continue making single crochet stitches until the end of the round.

Then make a slip stitch, cut the cord and hide it between loops inside the bag.
